## Peter Löscher

President and Chief Executive Officer of Siemens AG

Peter Löscher took over as President and Chief Executive Officer of Siemens AG on July 1, 2007. He is the twelfth CEO in the 160-year history of the company and the first to be named from outside Siemens. He had years of domestic and foreign experience in various companies in the pharmaceutical and medical fields.

His international management experience began in 1988 with the Hoechst Group, and in the course of his eleven years with the company he held top management positions in Spain, the United States, Britain and Japan. Later he moved to General Electric Healthcare and GE Healthcare Bio-Sciences. Immediately prior to his appointment as CEO of Siemens, he served as President of Global Human Health at Merck & Co, Inc., in the United States.

Peter Löscher studied economics at Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration and at the Chinese University of Hong Kong. He received his Master of Business Administration (MBA) from Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration. Peter Löscher graduated from the Advanced Management Program of Harvard Business School. He was born in Villach, Austria, is married and has three children.
